ONE GOD, THREE PERSONS

The perception of God as a Trinity, three persons in One God, equal in divinity and distinct in personality, has never been an easy topic to discuss. But if we go by what the Bible reveals about God, Trinity is the only way God can exist in Christianity. Exodus 20:1-2 tells us that God is one and no other. John 1:1,14 tells us that in the beginning exists the Word who was with God and who is God. This Word took flesh and dwelt among us as Jesus Christ. At the end of his earthly ministry, Jesus tells his disciples that he would pray to the Father to send them another Advocate who would come after him to live with us (Jn.14:16). Jesus further gives us a full dimension of the Trinity when he commissions his disciples to make disciples of all nations and baptize in the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit (Mt. 28:19). This does not mean three Gods. He is still One and undivided.

Because understanding this mystery is difficult, experts in Theology advise that God does not want us to know **how** He is a Trinity but only **why** He is a Trinity. In response to this, theologians teach that the reason God is a Trinity is to show us the kind of God he is and to share himself with us to help us know the kind of people we should be.

As a community of persons, Jesus reveals the triune nature of God and the inseparable union of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The mission of Jesus and of the Holy Spirit is the same, that is, to reveal the glory of God and to share that glory with us by uniting us in a community of love with the Father. That is why Jesus tells his disciples that the Spirit will reveal to you the glory of the Father and the Son (Jn.16:13).

As a community of persons united with us, God did not keep what He is to himself but shared it with the world in His Son (Jn. 3:16); Jesus broke the Bread of his Life and shared it for the life of the world (John 6:51) and the Holy Spirit shared his gifts freely to believers (1 Cor. 12:4ff). In other words, there is neither sectionalism nor isolationism in God. As the Trinity shares love, fellowship, and grace amongst themselves and with humanity (2 Cor. 13:14), so humans are required to live a life of sharing with the understanding that we are children of the Father, brothers and sisters of the Son, and temples of the Holy Spirit. This profound sense of community and love is a testament to the value and importance God places on each and every one of us.

So, the Trinity teaches us that God exists not in solitary individualism but in a community of persons, love, and sharing. This way, the Church tells us that God is a person who cherishes communication and wants to be reached. We are all brothers and sisters in the Trinity. This calls for a sense of gratitude that shows itself in worshipping God faithfully and loving our neighbor as God loves us.

God is only God in a Trinitarian relationship, and we can only be fully human in a relationship with him and with others. Our lives become Trinitarian by living in a community with God and our fellow brothers and sisters. We exist not just for ourselves, but for others. This is the essence of the life of the Holy Trinity, and as we are made in the image and likeness of God, it reflects the purpose of our lives. As we approach the table of the Lord today, let's open our hearts to the Trinity and embrace the divine love triangle. Understanding our purpose and finding fulfillment in it should inspire and motivate us in our daily lives.

UN DIOS, TRES PERSONAS

La percepción de Dios como una Trinidad, tres personas en un solo Dios, iguales en divinidad y distintas en personalidad, nunca ha sido un tema fácil de discutir. Pero si nos atenemos a lo que la Biblia revela acerca de Dios, la Trinidad es la única forma en que Dios puede existir en el cristianismo. Éxodo 20:1-2 nos dice que Dios es uno y no otro. Juan 1:1,14 nos dice que en el principio existe el Verbo que estaba con Dios y que es Dios. Esta Palabra se hizo carne y habitó entre nosotros como Jesucristo. Al final de su ministerio terrenal, Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que oraría al Padre para que les enviara otro Abogado que vendría después de él a vivir con nosotros (Jn.14:16). Jesús además nos da una dimensión completa de la Trinidad cuando encarga a sus discípulos hacer discípulos de todas las naciones y bautizar en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo (Mt. 28:19). Esto no significa tres dioses. Él sigue siendo Uno e indiviso.

Debido a que entender este misterio es difícil, los expertos en Teología advierten que Dios no quiere que sepamos **cómo** Él es una Trinidad sino sólo **por qué** Él es una Trinidad. En respuesta a esto, los teólogos enseñan que la razón por la que Dios es una Trinidad es para mostrarnos la clase de Dios que es y compartirse con nosotros para ayudarnos a saber la clase de personas que debemos ser.

Como comunidad de personas, Jesús revela la naturaleza trina de Dios y la unión inseparable del Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. La misión de Jesús y del Espíritu Santo es la misma, es decir, revelar la gloria de Dios y compartir esa gloria con nosotros uniéndonos en una comunidad de amor con el Padre. Por eso Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que el Espíritu os revelará la gloria del Padre y del Hijo (Jn.16:13).

Como comunidad de personas unidas a nosotros, Dios no guardó para sí lo que es, sino que lo compartió con el mundo en su Hijo (Jn. 3:16); Jesús partió el Pan de su Vida y lo compartió para la vida del mundo (Juan 6:51) y el Espíritu Santo compartió sus dones libremente con los creyentes (1 Cor. 12:4ss). En otras palabras, no hay seccionalismo ni aislacionismo en Dios. Así como la Trinidad comparte el amor, el compañerismo y la gracia entre ellos y con la humanidad (2 Cor. 13:14), los humanos deben vivir una vida de compartir con el entendimiento de que somos hijos del Padre, hermanos y hermanas del Hijo y templos del Espíritu Santo. Este profundo sentido de comunidad y amor es un testimonio del valor y la importancia que Dios otorga a todos y cada uno de nosotros.

Entonces, la Trinidad nos enseña que Dios existe no en un individualismo solitario sino en una comunidad de personas, de amor y de compartir. De esta manera, la Iglesia nos dice que Dios es una persona que valora la comunicación y quiere ser alcanzado. Todos somos hermanos y hermanas en la Trinidad. Esto requiere un sentido de gratitud que se manifiesta en adorar fielmente a Dios y amar a nuestro prójimo como Dios nos ama a nosotros. Dios es sólo Dios en una relación trinitaria, y sólo podemos ser plenamente humanos en una relación con él y con los demás. Nuestras vidas se vuelven trinitarias al vivir en comunidad con Dios y nuestros hermanos y hermanas. Existimos no sólo para nosotros mismos, sino para los demás. Esta es la esencia de la vida de la Santísima Trinidad, y como estamos hechos a imagen y semejanza de Dios, refleja el propósito de nuestras vidas. Al acercarnos hoy a la mesa del Señor, abramos nuestros corazones a la Trinidad y abracemos el triángulo amoroso divino. Comprender nuestro propósito y encontrar satisfacción en él debería inspirarnos y motivarnos en nuestra vida diaria.

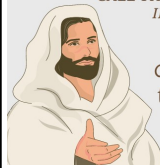
The Parish Office will be closed this Monday May 27, 2024 in honor of Memorial Day. There will be no ministry meetings on this day.
